### **Application period for Public Service Fellowship now open**

WASHINGTON, D.C., August 1, 2016 — The American Bar Association Section of Taxation is pleased to announce that it is now accepting applications for its Christine A. Brunswick Public Service Fellowship program class of 2017-2019.

The Fellowship program seeks to address the growing need for tax legal assistance and to foster a greater interest in tax-focused public service through funding and other support to young lawyers engaged in tax work for underserved communities. The Christine A. Brunswick Public Service Fellowships provide funding for the Fellows' salaries and benefits, as well as law school debt assistance, by means of charitable contributions to the Fellow's Sponsoring Organization. Applicants for the Fellowship identify and secure a position with a Sponsoring Organization before applying, though the employment may be contingent upon receipt of the Fellowship, and the proposed employment must involve taxation or tax administration. The Section plans to award up to two fellowships each year.

Applications must be received by November 18, 2016, to be considered. Interviews will be conducted during the Section's Midyear Meeting in Orlando, FL, on January 19-21, 2017. The Section will cover the cost of travel and accommodations for applicants selected for interviews.

The Section of Taxation developed the Public Service Fellowship in 2008. In 2013 the Fellowship was renamed the Christine A. Brunswick Public Service Fellowship in honor of the Section's former Executive Director of over 20 years. Christine was a strong proponent of advancing public service efforts in tax law and fostering a fair and equitable tax system. Under her leadership, the Section greatly expanded its commitment to public service and devoted significant resources in furtherance of that goal. The Section is proud to provide this Fellowship in Christine's honor.
