ORDER

Upon due consideration, Defendant Snipes' Motion For Limited Travel For Work Obligations (Doc. 486) to which the Government has filed a response in opposition (Doc. 489) is GRANTED. Defendant Snipes' Motion For Leave to File a Reply to the Government's Opposition to Snipes' Motion For Limited Travel For Work Obligations (Doc. 490) is DENIED AS MOOT.

The Defendant's existing conditions of release (Doc. 60) require, among other things, that he will be supervised in the Central District of California and shall report as directed by the Pretrial Services Office. Within ten (10) days from the date of this Order, the Pretrial Services Officer is requested to furnish to the Court (by filing a copy in this action) of any and all reporting instructions to which the Defendant is presently subject, and to make a report concerning the Defendant's record of compliance with those instructions. This Order will be subject to reconsideration after receipt of the report from the Pretrial Services Officer.
